

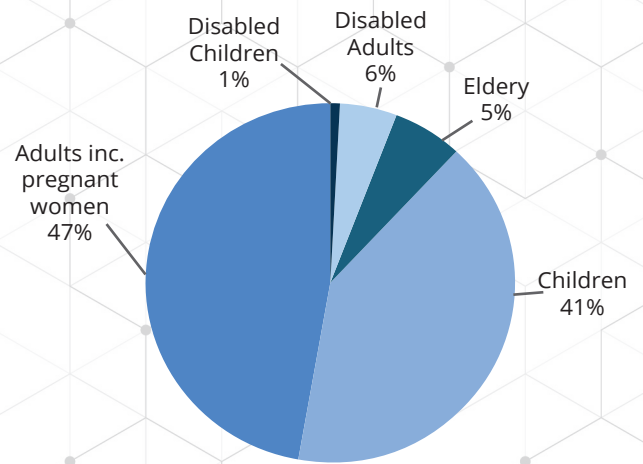
Medicaid provides health coverage and long term care services for Alaska's most vulnerable: children, seniors, people with disabilities, pregnant women, and very low income or working poor.

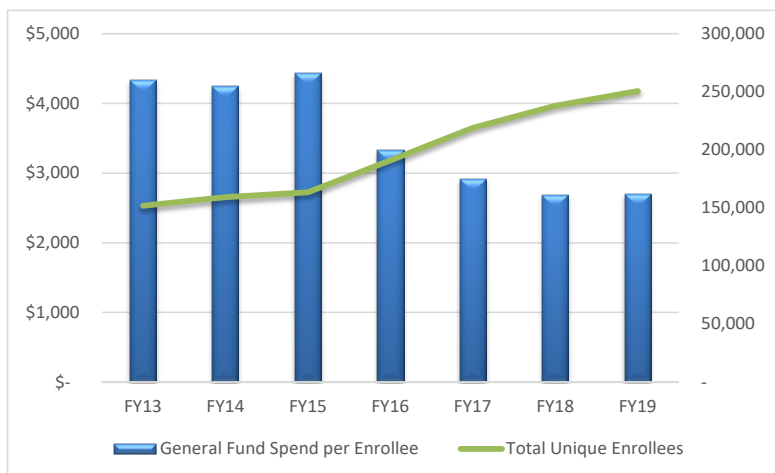

Medicaid Enrollment & General Fund Spend per Enrollee

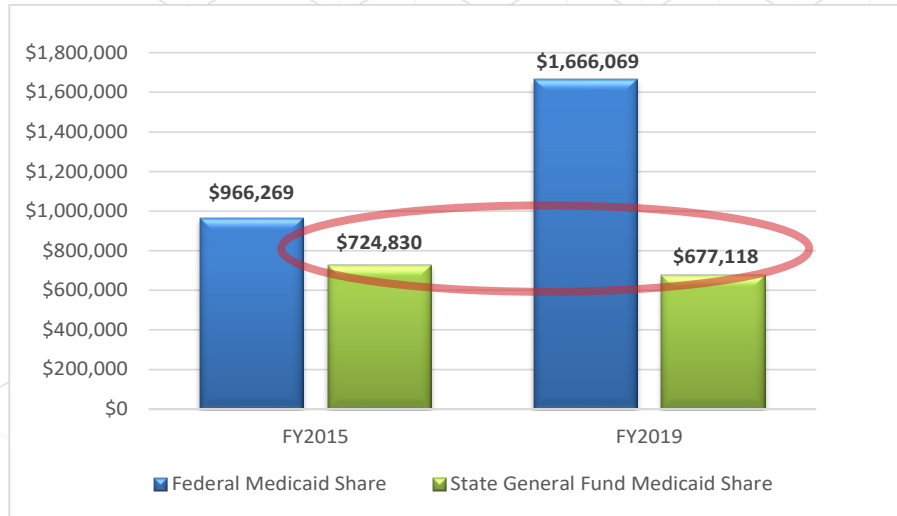


Medicaid general fund spend per enrollee has decreased 38% since 2013.

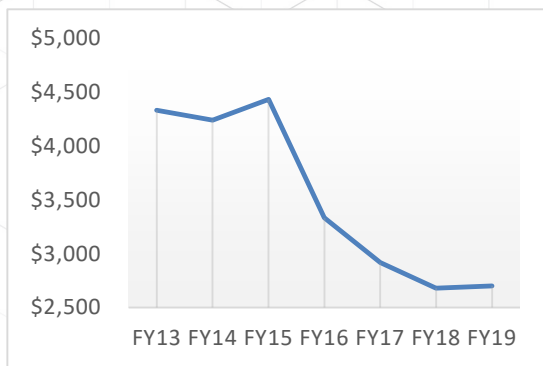
All of this while providing coverage to 98,832 more Alaskans.

Total general fund spend is less today than it was four years ago!

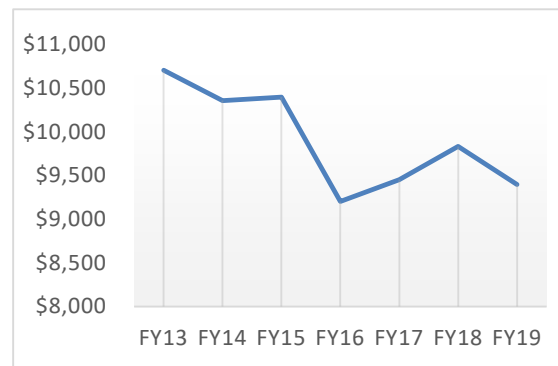
Cumulative Alaska Medicaid Spend FY15 vs FY19
