



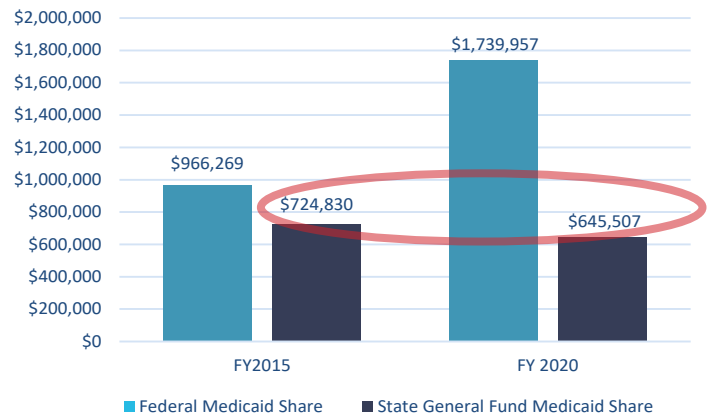
Medicaid in Alaska

Medicaid provides health coverage and long term care services for Alaska's most vulnerable: *children, seniors, people with disabilities, pregnant women, and very low income or working poor.*

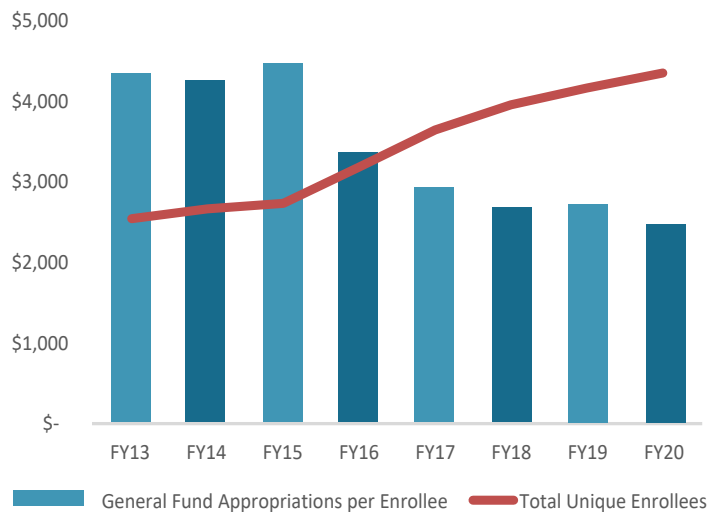
Alaska's Medicaid general fund budget is 11% less today than it was five years ago!

Alaska Medicaid Appropriations FY15 vs FY20

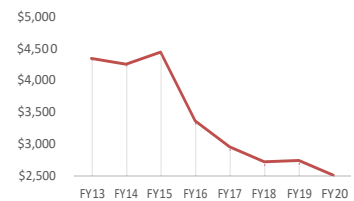


Medicaid GF appropriations per enrollee have decreased 43% since 2013. All of this while providing coverage to 110,058 more Alaskans.

Medicaid Enrollment & General Fund Appropriations per Enrollee

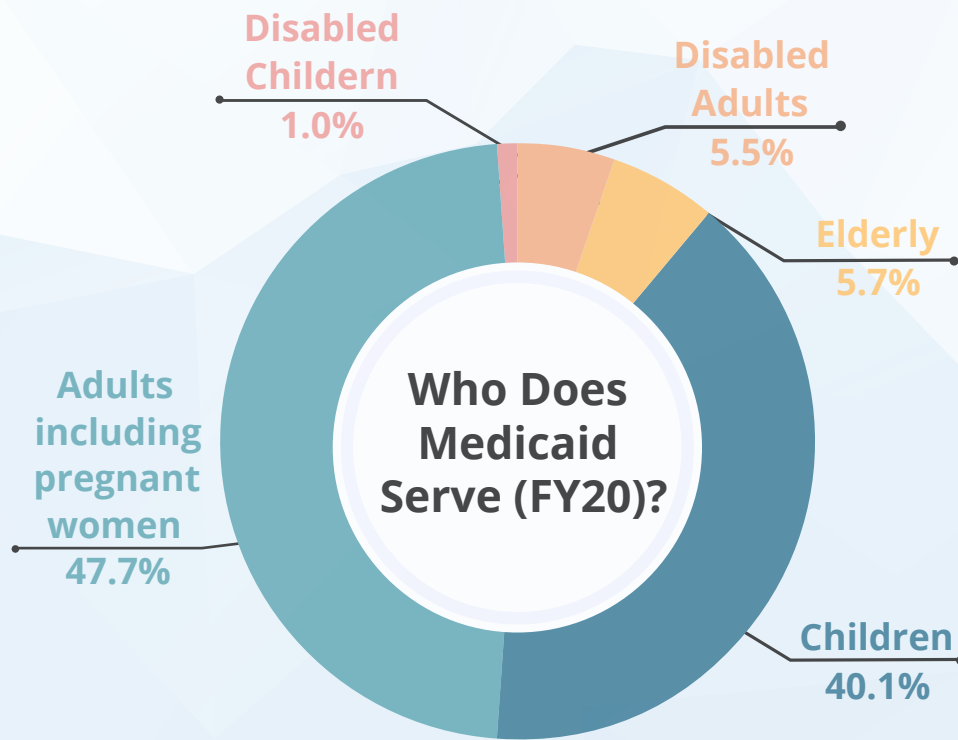


Trend: General Fund Appropriations per Enrollee
